Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy of Freeze Inc. (“Freeze”) outlines the types of cookies that we use on our websites located at freeze.com and account.freeze.com and/or in connection with any services provided by us and our policies and practices regarding the same. For purposes of this Cookie Policy, any capitalized terms used but not defined herein have the meanings set forth in our Privacy Policy located at https://freeze.com/en/Freeze_Inc_Privacy_Policy_Updated_2022-07-31.pdf.

According to <https://www.cloudflare.com/cookie-preferences/> on 2022-07-25:

"A cookie is a small piece of data (text file) that a website – when visited by a user – asks your browser to store on your device in order to remember information about you, such as your language preference or login information." (“Cookies”).

Web browsers sending HTTP and HTTPS requests to freeze.com may have Cookies set by three services:

1) Cloudflare

All HTTP and HTTPS requests sent to freeze.com and account.freeze.com pass through services hosted by Cloudflare. These services have the opportunity to set strictly necessary Cookies in responses to these requests. Web browsers may include these cookies in subsequent requests to freeze.com and account.freeze.com. Cloudflare declares the types and purposes of Cookies it may set in this document: <https://developers.cloudflare.com/fundamentals/get-started/reference/cloudflare-cookies/>

2) Stripe

The responses to some requests sent to account.freeze.com will reference a JavaScript file maintained and hosted by Stripe. When web browsers request this file over HTTPS, Stripe's services have the opportunity to set Cookies in responses to these requests. Web browsers may include these Cookies in subsequent requests to account.freeze.com and services hosted by Stripe. Stripe declares the types and purposes of Cookies it may set in this document: <https://stripe.com/legal/cookies-policy>

Freeze strongly recommends that all users visit <https://stripe.com/cookie-settings> to manage the Cookies set by Stripe's services.

3) Freeze

The response to an HTTPS sign-in request sent to account.freeze.com will set the strictly necessary "__Host_" Cookie containing a identifier to reference an active user session. Web

browsers must include these Cookies in subsequent requests account.freeze.com to receive services from Freeze.
